Production Definition:

Hormone Free Nonfat Dry Milk is obtained by the removal of water from pasteurized skim milk. It contains not more than 5% moisture (by weight) and not more than 1.5% milkfat (by weight) unless otherwise indicated. Hormone Free Nonfat Dry Milk for human consumption complies with all provisions of the U.S. Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act.
